#### V. Strengthening AFE Stakeholders' Capacity in Climate Change Adaptation & Readiness

- The first batch of Training on Managing Risk in Agriculture due to Climate Change was conducted in Central Mindanao University-Farmers Training Center, University Town, Musuan, Dologon, Maramag, Bukidnon. It was participated by the Chairmen of the Committee on Agriculture in Municipal and Barangay levels. The participants came up with an action plan which they will implement when they go back to their respective barangays/ municipalities.
- As part of the Tree for Life Project, 60 rambutan fruit trees were planted at Central Mindanao University. Each fruit tree was given 4 kls. of vermicast. Twenty nine councilors who were participants of the Training on Climate Change were also given 3 kinds of fruit trees (rambutan, guyabano and guava) with 2 kilos of vermi compost to plant in their homes.
