**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF
PROCUREMENT – NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT: SCIENTIFIC, SCHOLARLY OR ARTISTIC
WORK, EXCLUSIVE TECHNOLOGY AND MEDIA SERVICES**

Section 53.6 and Item V, Letter D, No. 6 of Annex “H” A of 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184

BAC Resolution No. ISD-12-06, s. 2020

WHEREAS, as a general rule, all procurements shall be done through competitive bidding except whenever justified by the conditions in order to promote economy and efficiency, may resort to any alternative method of procurement;

WHEREAS, one of the functions of BAC is to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) the mode of procurement to be undertaken to meet the actual conditions and to ensure that the same is most advantageous to the government;

WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act” provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;

WHEREAS, under Section 53 (Negotiated Procurement), Item No. 53.6 (Scientific, Scholarly or Artistic Work, Exclusive Technology and Media Services) allows procurement of goods, infrastructure project, and consulting services that can be contracted to a particular supplier, contractor or consultant and as determined by HOPE, which includes Media Services, among others, that covers media documentation, advertisement, or announcement through television, radio, newspaper, internet, and other communication media;

WHEREAS, to justify the need to procure through this negotiated modality, the End-User shall conduct a market study and determine the probable sources. This study should confirm that the supplier, contractor or consultant could undertake the project at more advantageous terms. In all cases, the market study must be conducted prior to the commencement of the procurement process;

WHEREAS, the end-user justifies based on their market study/research that procurement of **Media Services** which include documentation and airing through negotiated procurement under Section 53.6 is more efficient, economical and advantages of the government, see attached Market Study;

WHEREAS, the Information Services Division prepared a Purchase Request No. ISD FUND 2020-11-46 for the Block Time Radio Program Slot and Production Services for the Nationwide Promotion of Programs and Services of the Department of Agriculture and its Bureaus and attached agencies. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Php 3,541,000.00 in accordance with its PPMP;

WHEREAS, based on the Market Study and Approved Purchase Request, the BAC prepared and sent a Request for Quotation/Proposal and negotiated to the identified service provider, Manila Broadcasting Company (MBC);

WHEREAS, in response to the RFP/RFQ, MBC submitted their proposal together with the required eligibility requirements stipulated in RA 9184 and its Revised IRR;

NOW THEREFORE, in the consideration of the foregoing, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, *herby RESOLVE AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED* to:

- 1. Recommend Alternative Method of Procurement through Negotiated Procurement – Scientific, Scholarly or Artistic Work, Exclusive Technology and Media Services as provided in Sec. 53.6 and Item V, Letter D, No. 6 of Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184; and**

- 2. **Recommend the approval and award by the ATI Director of this Resolution and Purchase Order/Contract to Manila Broadcasting Company as the service provider for Block Time Radio Program Slot and Production Services for the Nationwide Promotion of Programs and Services of the Department of Agriculture and its Bureaus and attached agencies with the contract amount of Php 3,541,000.00.**
