SUBJECT : SEARCH FOR THE YOUNG FILIPINO FARM LEADERS TRAINING PROGRAM IN JAPAN (YFFLTPJ) BATCH 2019

In relation to the Young Filipino Farm Leaders Training Program in Japan (YFFLTPJ) Batch 2019, we are hereby informing you to formally announce the search and start of the selection process from the local level. The YFFLTPJ Operational Guidelines, revised as of May 2018 will serve as your reference in implementing the program.

Nominees should meet the following criteria and submit the required documents:

1. Young Filipino farmer who is an in or out of school youth;
2. Male or Female, Single, 20-27 years old at the time of application (for out of school youth) and third year college level (for in school youth);
3. A member of 4-H Club in the Philippines for at least one year (for both in or out of school youth);
4. Has no live-in partner and/or child;
5. High school graduate or college level (undergraduate);
6. Not presently employed in any job at the time of application;
7. Must have at least three (3) years accumulated farming experience at the time of application;
8. Has an available farm of at least 0.1 ha and/or with existing and owned agri-based projects such as crops, livestock, swine, poultry and fisheries;
9. Has no overdue obligations from the ATI at the time of application;
10. Of good community standing;
11. A good communicator, and can speak and understand English;
12. Proof that has no physical deformities, tattoo nor piercing in any part of the body;
13. Willing to learn Nihongo and new technologies;
14. With valid passport to be presented during the regional exam;
15. No previous travel to Japan; and
16. Dental examination; medical tests for Hepatitis B and HIV/AIDS; chest X-ray, drug and neuro-psychological test to be done in diagnostic clinics/hospitals or laboratories accredited by the Department of Health.
